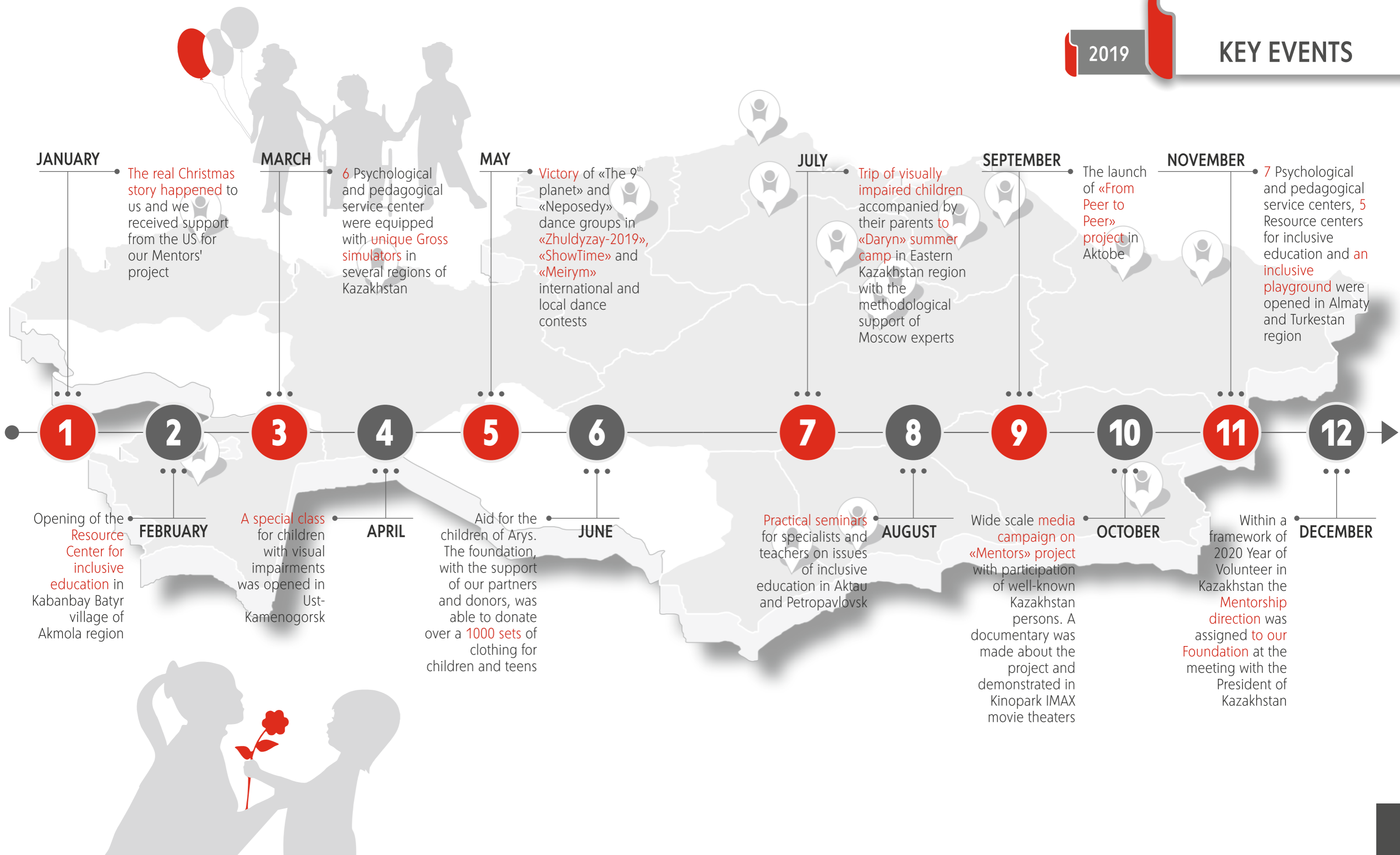

He rides a bike, helps at home, likes to feed goats and is doing everything a child of his age is capable of. He like helps his father in his work with leather and wood. For example, he crafted a wooden sword and shield for himself. He's very curious and kind kid.

Abdulaziz is growing in a usual family with many children, which is modestly but friendly, where parents believe in their

children and support each other. Given the circumstances, Abdulaziz is the family's favourite. His father devotes lots of time to him, teaches him math and reads fairy tales in Kazakh that Abdulaziz later reproduces.

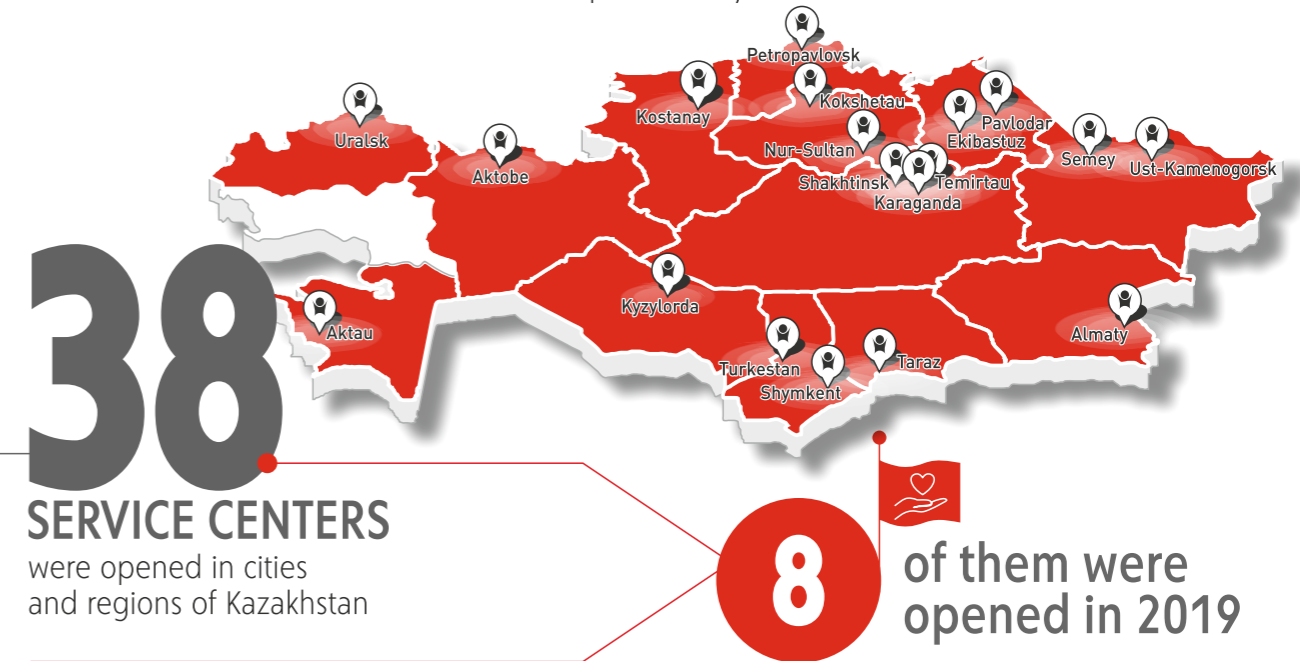

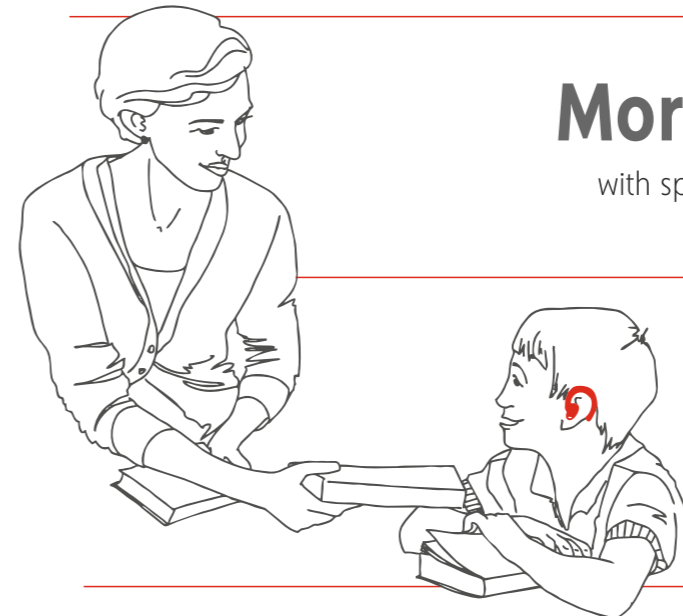

Aruzhan is a first grade pupil. She is adored by her classmates and is one of the kindest kids in the class. This is also noted by Gulnar Shumatovna, coordinator of the Resource center of inclusive education: «If a teacher drops a chalk or a pen, Aruzhan is right there to help to pick it up. She is a very kind and open child and in spite of peculiarities of her development she a very communicative girl!»

Aruzhan has a special educational needs. When she first came to class she didn't speak, although she understood everything, and she could not write like other children of her age. Now, Aruzhan can speak by syllables and can hold a pen trying to write letters of paper which is a great progress in her

development. Although the motility lessons are quite difficult Aruzhan is trying hard. There are disciplines that she likes a lot, singing and choreography, she's got good grades in math and she likes putting puzzles together. It is worthwhile to mention here the joint work of the specialists of the center, speech therapist, psychologist and other teachers. All of it produced results.

«Little by little we learn how to read and write. But what makes me the most happy is that when she comes home from school she says that she has many friends. As she is a girl who enjoys company», - Kulyan Tokova, Aruzhan's mother says smiling. «I see the progress made by my daughter and I believe that our great achievements are yet ahead!»

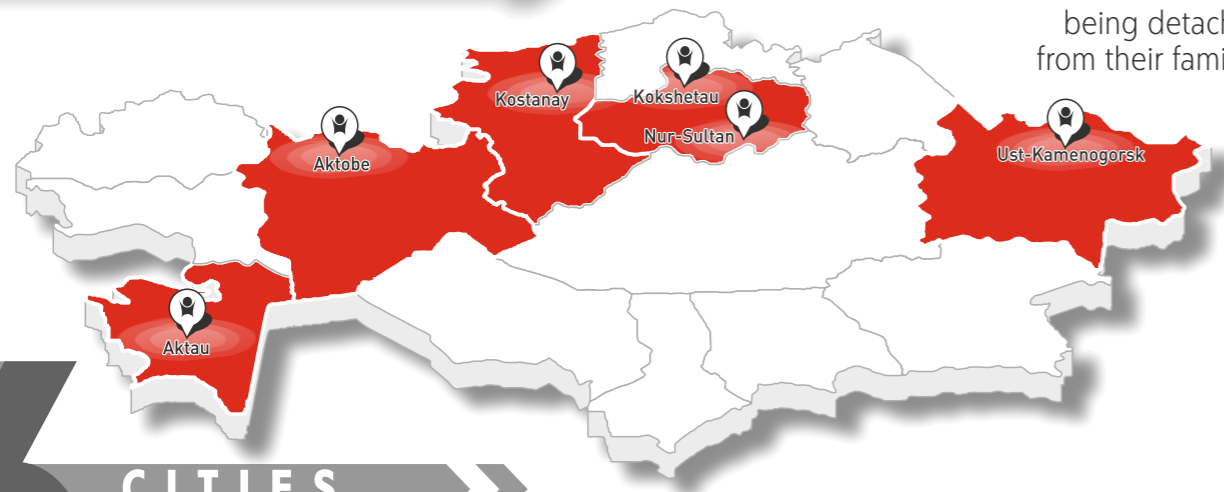

« Mommy, I want to be a constructor and inventor», - my son often tells me, - «I want to help sightless people, I want to create a blog or youtube channel and to shoot a video guide for parents of kids with special needs, a guide that would help them not to get lost, make the right decision and love their child as he is and help him to develop. Because every child deserves this», - this is how Karlygash, Dias' mother, began her story.

Everybody close to Dias believe in Dias from his early childhood and do everything possible for him to grow up independent, sporty and confident boy. It will take long to list all of Dias' achievements: this, when he was 6 years old he decided to study Koran and know he knows most of it in Braille alphabet. He's admired by Braille alphabet and he's happy that it was invented for sightless people, he's grateful to Lois Braille for it.

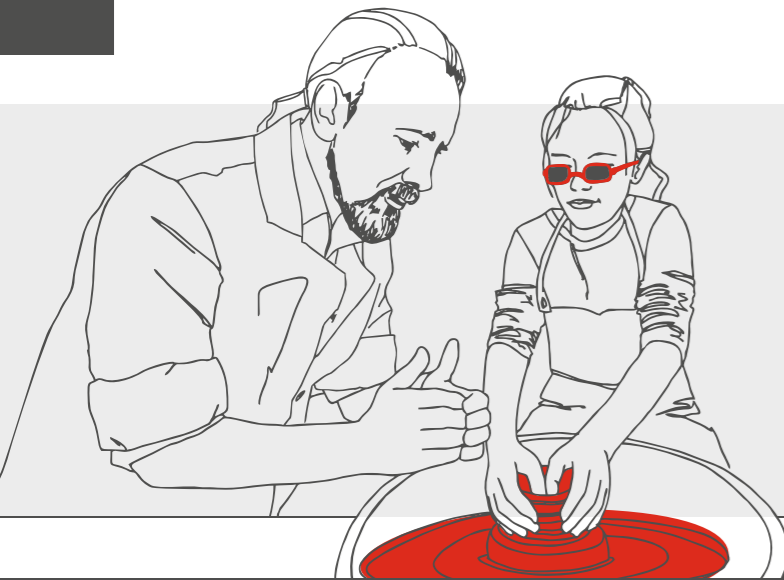
Since the age of three Dias engaged in molding and origami and he's taken the 1st place in the competition for children with limited possibilities. Karlygash recalls how she was buying play dough to develop his hands movements and

they were molding together, was trying to find leads, paper and writing devices for sightless kids. He often learns things with his elder sister. Dias likes sports. He skates, does goal balling and judo. He's always winning competitions where he competes as equal. And Dias also a great singer. «He won the 2nd place in «Zhuldyzay» contest and is taking professional vocal lessons since 2019 making great success,» - Karlygash says.

Three years ago, having learnt about opening of a special class for blind children in Aktau from social media, Karlygash and her son got in touch with the school. Dias was dreaming of finding friends and studying at school and his dream came true! «Dias has got lots of plans. And I never get tired of learning from my children. Dias is very wise for his age, he is my miracle, my heart, my fighter. I love him with all my heart and he inspires me!» - these are the feelings shared by Dias' mother.

There's only one thing that might be added to the above, if a child is loved and trusted in he will be happy and a true citizen of his country no matter what!

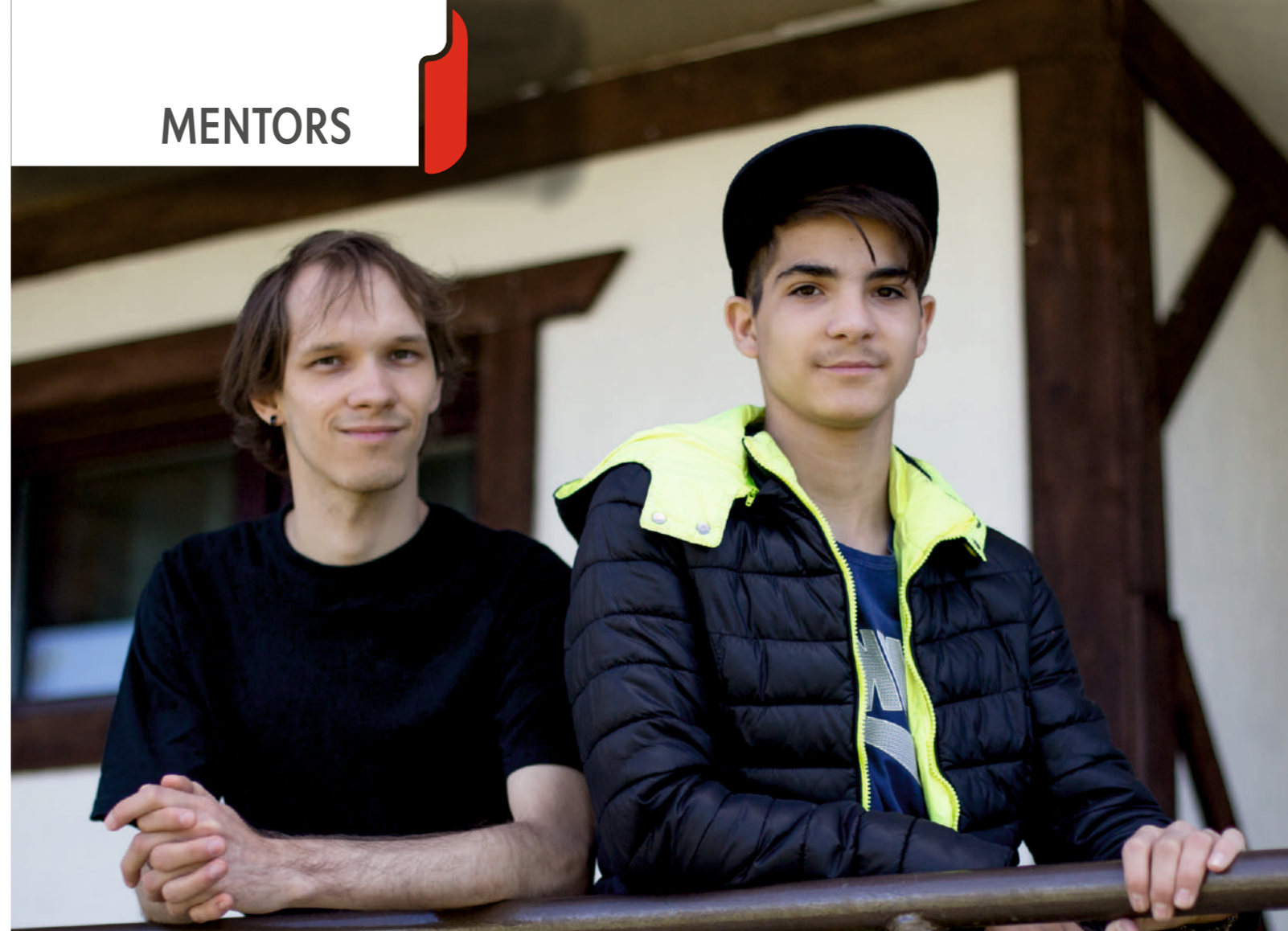

In the beginning of 2019, together with Yelena Kogay, my coach, have set ambitious goals – to choose a profession for further application to college and also to get me ready for independent life in the Youth House. I was graduating the 9th grade and couldn't decide whether to choose a profession of cook or designer. Yelena helped me to make up my mind, to understand what my strong features are, to understand what I want. She was telling me about other professions and we were looking at many options. As a result, I decided to apply to the architectural college.

Moreover, Lena helped me to get ready for the transfer from the orphanage to the Youth House. For many kids this is a very emotional and distressing moment: if previously we used to be completely taken care of by the staff of an orphanage, then upon graduation one should rely mainly on oneself. Lena taught me how to cook simple dishes, how to spend

money and how to distribute my scholarship.

At first glance, this might seem minuscular but it was a real life saving for me. I was greatly concerned that I won't be admitted to college, won't be able to deal with an adult independent life in the Youth House. But thanks to Lena, who kept cheering me up, I learnt how to trust in myself.

Now I'm a 1st year student. I'm happy that everything worked out fine and grateful to Lena. I know that I can approach her for support, advice and help with personal issues at any moment and she is always there for me. Although I don't have a mentor or older comrade, Lena became my friend and a very close person. We keep working together and are now setting goals for 2020 which I'm sure I will be able to achieve with the help of my coach.

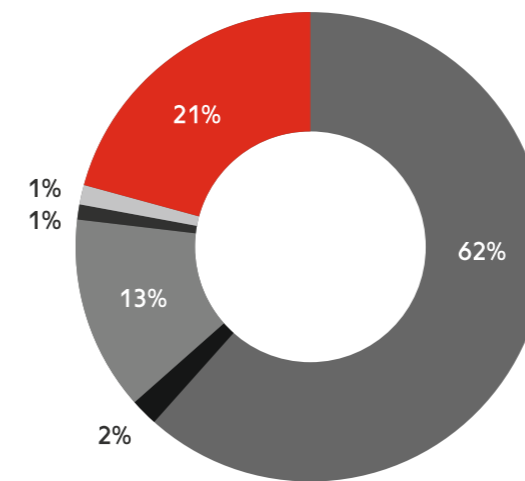
