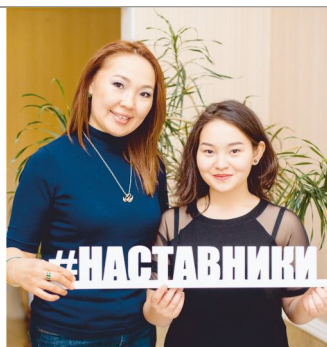

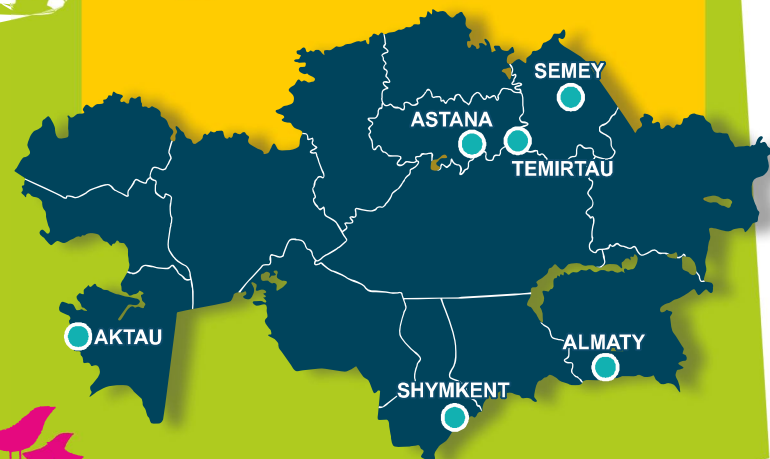

TEMIRBAEVA SABINA, 7 YEARS OLD

A child with special educational needs



Sabina is a favored child in her family. When she was 2 years old, it became obvious that she not only had issues with her musculoskeletal system, but other problems as well. This worried the Temirbayev family, which is why they came to their local Service Center to ask for help from our specialists. Here, Sabina took classes with a speech therapist, psychologist, and a defectologist, while also attending physical and musical therapy. Sabina is also a member of an orchestra created at her local PPSC. In 2018, their orchestra won 1st place at the international musical contest «Tonic».

When the time came for Sabina to attend first grade, there was no longer any questions or worries regarding what school would be a good fit for her – she would definitely be able to attend a public school, with a general educational program, which was located near her house. The family's choice was supported by the school and the specialists at the Service Center. As part of the «Different, but equal» project, a Resource center for Inclusive education was opened, where teachers and, of course, Sabina receives the necessary assistance and any extra help with her school work.

Sabina's mother: «Sabina has made many new friends, which helped us realize that not only did we make the right decision, but also that our girl will succeed, and that she has the same abilities as all of her other peers».

TEMIRLAN, 17 YEARS OLD

An orphan at the city of Astana's Orphanage, with a mentor for 3 years:

«– How do you think you have changed since your mentor became a part of your life?

– Everything has changed. I became a different person. Before meeting my mentor, I had a different character. I was angry and hated my life, and didn't want this life to be my fate. But now, with my mentor being a part of my life, I crossed that stage, and decided to live life to the fullest, and became happy. Now everything is great, I am very happy, because I learned that you need to appreciate the things that you get in life».

Within the framework of the project «Educational Courses», three children from Almaty and Astana's orphanages got into universities on faculties of «Medicine», «Biotechnology» and «Information Technologies» in Medical University of Astana, KazNTU named after Satpayev and the Kazakh-British University. 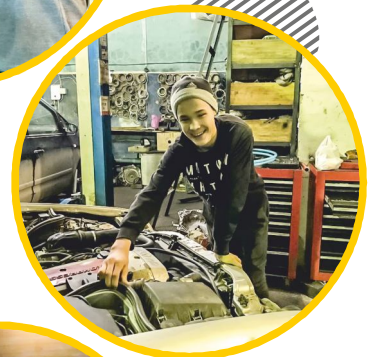
Orphanage undergraduates both in Astana and Almaty have completed professional training internships, which will hopefully help them gain useful skills for their future careers.

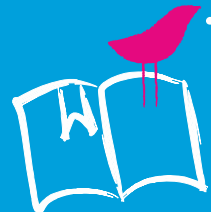

PROJECT «DISCOVER THE WORLD»



A specialized class for sightless and visually impaired children was open in Kostanay, which is equipped with typhlo-equipment, a safety zone, and all the necessary teaching materials. A separate class was organized according to the system of Montessori in the capital school-gymnasium №10. Specialized classes in Astana, Aktau and Aktope received 11 braille typewriters. Work has begun on opening a class for visually impaired children in Ust-Kamenogorsk and groups at a kindergarten in Kokshetau.

ABLAY, 11 YEARS OLD

Sightless child, a student of a special class for children with visual impairments at the gymnasium № 10 in Astana:

«Before, my world was very small. The only things I knew were my room, where all my toys were, how many steps I needed to take to get to the window, but one day everything changed. My mom told me that I would go to a special center where I could learn, and I would be able to make new friends. Now, I discover something new for myself every day! Yesterday I learned how to walk up the stairs by myself, and today I learned how to open and close doors. But what I look most forward to is tomorrow!» - These are the words of Mustafin Ablay, who at the age of 7 began to visit the Psychological and pedagogical service center in Astana and who continues to receive services from specialists. Today, Ablay, who is a pupil of the specialized class 3E, for sightless and visually impaired children of the gymnasium № 10 in Astana is: The winner of the Republican and International Olympiads in Mental Math, has won the title of Superchampion at the International Mental Mathematics Olympiad among students of the CIS countries, and will represent Kazakhstan at the World Olympiad in Germany and Turkey.

MARAL AKHMETOVA

A tutor at an inclusive theater studio where children from school №83 take classes:

«Children with special educational needs from inclusive classes who attend the theatrical art course, work and learn alongside ordinary children, which makes it obvious that it is more difficult for them to adapt to the stage, to perform a role, to learn the dialogue by heart, to go on stage, and to speak in front of the audience, because to them, it is all new. A student in the 2nd grade, Valery Yugai, loves this club with all his heart. He did not miss a single lesson, began attentively listening to the teacher, and carried out all his tasks. At the end of the school year, he showed great results. Went on stage like a real artist and performed his role. Even if the role seemed small and insignificant, for us it was an indicator. An indicator of the fact that children with special educational needs can play and portray a character just as well, and can be equally involved in the creative process».

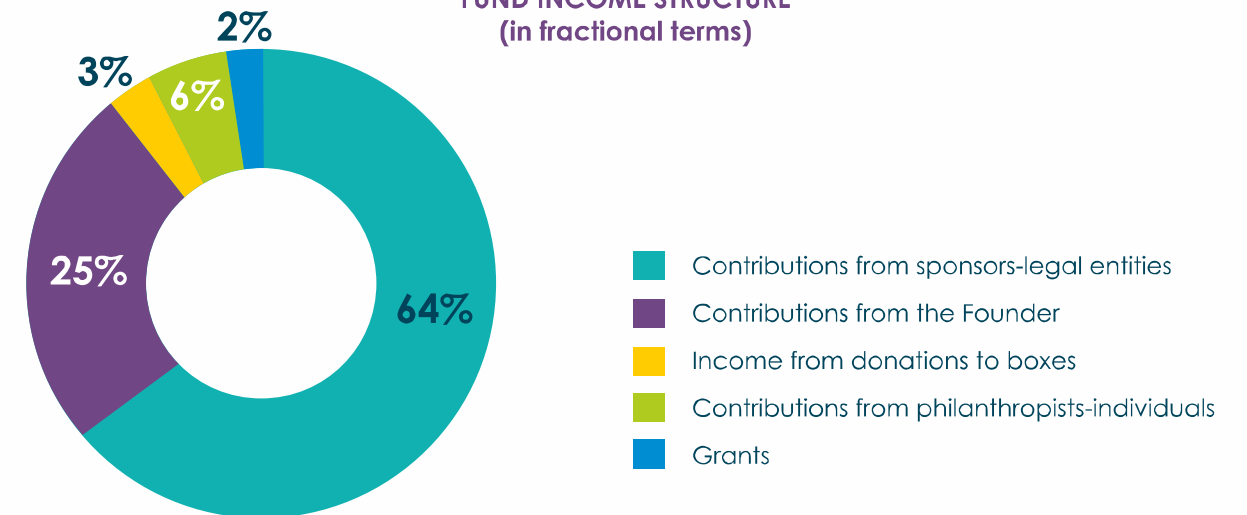
